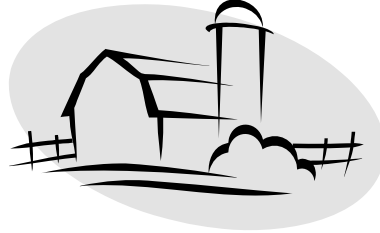


# New Hampshire 2012 CSA's
