NOTICE

RESTRICTIONS FOR THE USE OF TURF FERTILIZER

(For Homeowners AND Commercial Users)

To Avoid Harmful Runoff, NH Law, RSA 431:4-e, Prohibits the Following:

- Application within 25 feet of water or storm drains or where it can enter storm drains
- Application during or immediately before heavy rain
- Application where grass is not actively growing including frozen ground and impervious surfaces

Legal Requirements

- NH RSA 431:4-e, Chapter 431, Soil and Plant Additives
- NH RSA 483-B:9, Chapter 483-B, Shoreland Water Quality Protection Act, Minimum Shoreland Protection Standard

When cyanobacteria multiply to form a bloom, they can produce enough cyanotoxins to affect human and animal health.

Exposure occurs through ingestion, inhalation or skin contact.

Symptoms of exposure to cyanobacteria vary but can include skin irritation, stomach cramps, vomiting, nausea, diarrhea, fever, sore throat, headache, muscle and joint pain, mouth blisters, and acute liver damage.

Long-term exposure can harm the liver and central nervous system. Cyanobacteria blooms can be fatal to dogs that drink the water or lick themselves after swimming.
