On-Farm Readiness Reviews (OFRR) are voluntary, non-regulatory farm visits, conducted by New Hampshire's Produce Safety Team, to evaluate preharvest, harvest, and post-harvest processes, assess if growers are ready for a produce safety inspection, and identify areas for improvement in food safety practices.

OFFR's will be conducted by DAMF Produce Safety Program Team members and UNH Extension Educators. All notes recorded by the PSP Team members will remain with you and will not be available to the public.
