



WPS CENTRAL LOCATION INFORMATION

Agricultural employers must display the Pesticide Application Information below, at a Central Location on the establishment, whenever a Worker or Handler is present and, within the past 30 days, a WPS-labeled pesticide has been applied or a Restricted-Entry Interval (REI) has been in effect.

*-In addition to the Pesticide Application Information above, the Pesticide Safety Information (**Poster**) and Hazard Information (**OSHA Safety Data Sheets**) must also be displayed at the Central Location*

-This information must be displayed within 24 hours after the end of the application if Workers or Handlers are on the establishment & before workers enter treated areas

*-A record must be kept of the **Pesticide Application Information** and the **Hazard Information** for 2 years from the expiration date of the Restricted-Entry Interval of the pesticide applied*
